Adjectives

Adjectives are words that describe things.

Point 1: Adjectives can go **after** a **be** verb.

1. My class is fun.
2. My teacher is nice.

Point 2: Adjectives can go **before** a **noun**.

1. I have a big house.
2. That is a nice bag.
3. He is a good teacher.

Point 3: You can put **adjectives together**.
