




## Days of the Week

**Point 1:** Spell the names of the week with a **capital letter**.

1. Monday | on Monday
2. Tuesday | on Tuesday
3. Wednesday | on Wednesday
4. Thursday | on Thursday
5. Friday | on Friday
6. Saturday | on Saturday
7. Sunday | on Sunday

**Point 2:** In spoken English, speakers often do not say the preposition **on**.

1. I will see you Sunday.
2. I will see you on Sunday.

## Parts of the Day

**Point 3:** We use **different prepositions** for some parts of the day, either **in** or **at**.

1. morning | in the morning
2. noon | at noon
3. afternoon | in the afternoon
4. evening | in the evening
5. night | at night
6. midnight | at midnight.

**Point 4:** When you **combine** a day of the week and a part of the day, you do NOT need a **preposition, except with noon and midnight**. The **time of day** goes **after the day**.

1. I will see you Monday night.
2. Let's meet Sunday afternoon.
3. I will see you Friday at noon.

## Parts of the Week

**Point 5:** The **weekend** is **Saturday and Sunday**, and the **Weekdays** are **Monday thru Friday**.

1. Weekend | on the weekend
2. Weekday | on a weekday
3. Weekdays | during the weekdays.
