



Verbs in Simple Present Tense (First Person)

We use the simple present to talk about actions we do again and again.

Point 1: WH questions use the following pattern.

- Wh + **do** + noun / pronoun + **verb** ... ?

1. What **do** you **do**?
2. Where **do** you **live**?
3. How **do** you **get** to school?
4. When **do** you **exercise**?
5. Why **do** you **want** a pet?

Point 2: Affirmative statements use the following pattern:

1. I work for a tech company.
2. I live near the station.
3. I take the bus.
4. I play soccer every Monday night.

Point 3: Negative statements use the following pattern:

1. I **do not** work from home.
2. I **do not** live near my work.
3. I **don't** drive to work.
4. I **don't** exercise that much.

In spoken English we often say **don't** instead of **do not**.

Point 4: Yes/No questions use the following pattern:

- **Do** + noun / pronoun + **verb** ... ?

1. Do you like tennis?
2. Do you have a car?
3. Do you cook a lot?
4. Do you want a pet?

Point 5: You do not need to repeat the verb when you answer a Yes/No question.

1. Do you like tennis?
2. Yes, I do. (Yes, I like tennis.)
3. No, I don't. (No, I don't like tennis.)

4. It depends. (Sometimes yes and sometimes no.)
