



Can - Requests / Permission - Grammar Notes

Point 1: Use **can** for polite requests.

1. **Can** you hold the door for me?
2. **Can** you come to work early tomorrow?
3. **Can** you spell your name for me?
4. **Can** you not sit there?

Point 2: When answering polite requests, we usually do not say 'Yes' or 'No!' We use special phrases.

To reply 'Yes' you can say:

- Sure
- Of course.
- I would be glad to.

To reply 'No' we might say the following:

- I'm sorry, (give reason).
- I'd rather not.

Point 3: Use **can** to ask for permission.

- **Can** I leave early?
- **Can** I borrow your car?
- **Can** I sit here?
- **Can** I go home early?

Point 4: When answering polite requests, we usually do not say 'Yes' or 'No!' We use special phrases

To reply 'Yes' you can say:

- Sure
- Of course
- Be my guest

To reply 'No' we might say the following:

- I'm sorry, (give reason)
- I'd rather you didn't.


To Decrease
