Quantifiers - Much / Many/ A lot of / Lots of

Point 1: The quantifiers **much** and **many** go before nouns and express quantity.

1. I do not have **much** money.
2. We do not have **much** time.
3. I have **many** friends.
4. There are not **many** people here.

Point 2: The word **much** is used for uncountable nouns. It is mainly used only in negative statements.

1. We do not have much space.
2. There is not much crime in my town.
3. I do not get much rain in winter.
4. They do not have much work right now.

Point 3: The word **many** is used for countable nouns, which are plural nouns that usually end with -s.

1. Do you have many foreign friends?
2. There are many trees in the park.
3. She has so many pairs of shoes.
4. We do not get many tourists in winter.

Point 4: The words **a lot of** and **lots of** are used instead of **much** for affirmative statements.

1. We have **a lot of** fruit in the fridge.
2. We made **lots of** food for the picnic.
3. We get **lots of** snow in winter.
4. They own **a lot of** crypto currency.
