Meaning: Soft, sticky, and slightly melted inside.

Examples:

1. The chocolate brownie was so gooey and delicious.
2. I love when the cheese in my sandwich is gooey and warm.

You can't go wrong

Meaning: A phrase used to say that something is always a good choice.

Examples:

1. You can't go wrong with a classic chocolate chip cookie.
2. If you're looking for a great movie, you can't go wrong with this one.

There's plenty more where that came from

Meaning: There is a lot more of something available.

Examples:

1. If you love chocolate, there's plenty more where that came from!
2. Don't worry about running out of snacks—there's plenty more where that came from.

Meaning: The most important thing to someone.

Examples:

1. Finishing my assignment is my number one priority today.
2. Her number one priority is spending time with her family.

the list is long

Meaning: There are many things to mention.

Examples:

1. When it comes to my favorite foods, the list is long.
2. The list is long, but my top travel destinations are Japan, Italy, and France.

To Undergo Surgery

If you undergo surgery, you have a medical operation.

To Have a Check-up

To Prescribe
